Sudhanshu Trivedi

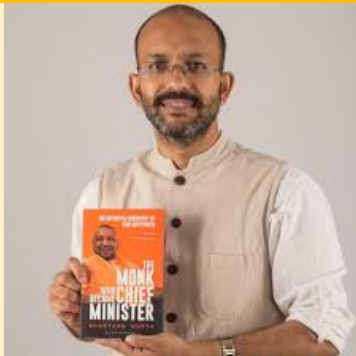
